Updates from the Last meeting:

No new updates from Gar on Guest Role Access. CC FUG will put this on the agenda for the March meeting.

Name Change:

Lacey had brought this question to the CC FUG in one of the previous meetings. There is no standard list of acceptable documents that are being used by the campuses before changing the Name field in PeopleSoft. No new updates were shared but meanwhile, this question is being sent to Pat Seaworth to get his guidance. We will discuss this in the next meeting.

Update on DR's:

Gar is working on the Guest role. The programmers are working on the K12 report and also working tickets on Collaborative reports, Minnesota reciprocity report [NDSU reported that it does not include all the students], Photo load process.

Ethnicity-Bio demo:

Mary reviewed it and cannot get the students to have more than one primary ethnicity in PeopleSoft. Also, some students do not have the ethnicity field populated. She is unable to replicate Viet Doan's problem in PeopleSoft - asking Viet to email some sample EMPL ID's.

Residency Data:

The residency is defined in the NDUS procedure 504. The group discussed the issues with allowing the student to change the address. Queries and reports do not use a consistent address field [between Permanent/Home/Dorm etc] which causes the reporting data to be inconsistent. Also mentioned was that there are 4 different types of residency codes. Mary indicated that the campuses were told in the initial PeopleSoft training to use the second tab on the residency page to mark the actual residency and use the first tab to address the campus tuition calc. purposes. Also, the residency field is institution specific.
