Discussion

- Race/Ethnicity Data Collection and Reporting
 - Discussion regarding Student Records request to change coding from 63 ethnic groups to the 6 needed/required for IPEDS reporting. Campus Solutions is currently updating the system to open for student self service re-identification; timing is critical.
 - Suzanne Anderson indicated for programming and for clean data efforts, this move would simplify the process. In addition, these are the choices the data source (common application) has as well as what is required for reporting by IPEDS.
 - Earlier today, Lacey sent an email to Admissions Users group – they supported the move to have data match the common admission application.
 - Julie inquired if additional data was wanted for internal and external reporting purposes on each campus as well as long-term data researching.
 - Gar clarified how specific ethnic groups fold into summary groups (the essential groups).

- Suzanne is willing to collaborate with Admissions and create an ‘issues’ document discussing the implications of simplifying the race/ethnicity selections. Document will be sent to Julie, Mick and Mary.
- Campus Community User Group members unanimously supported the change to six race/ethnicity categories.
- Recommendation to talk to campus researchers as well as various VP Councils. This group’s recommendation would go to the CAC as well as additional Councils.
